Minutes of Wednesday, September 26, 2007, Unapproved

- Discussed purchase of one or more weed wrenches
- Donation from SPACE
- Community gathering at Bulkely property (Cornish's most recently conserved property) on October 13, 10-3
- Fitch property being considered by LCHIP

**Tree Planting:** Loel described the limited locations at the Fairgrounds for shade trees as well as work and funds required. It was decided to plant in the spring to enable better preparation and community participation.

**White Swan Farm:** The Commission discussed Gayle Davis's request to place a small cabin on her conserved property for recreation purposes (pool/ice skating house). Don has consulted with UVLT and NH Conservation Land Stewardship Program (who hold an interest in the property). Gabe will send a letter permitting this structure and associated conditions.

**NH Fish & Game Wildlife Action Plan:** Cornish is on a list of towns being considered for a workshop on wildlife maps in conservation planning, master plans, and natural resource inventories.

**Planning for More Efficient Recycling:** Bill reported on a presentation on a feasibility study to construct a new materials recovery facility for recyclable materials for Sullivan County.

**Fire Pond:** Dan reported that the fire pond near the highway garage has been dredged.

**Jackson Road:** Arthur Brown wants to make a berm on his property to manage water.

**Adjournment:** Jim made a motion to adjourn at 8:15. John seconded and the vote passed.
