Fitch LCHIP Application: Gabe asked that, due to his conflict of interest, someone else take over as the point person on the Jim and Sue Fitch LCHIP application. Jon Woodhull volunteered. \

Farnsworth Property: The offer the Dot Farnsworth made to the commission was discussed. The need to appraise the land was discussed. Loel made a motion to expend up to \$1000 from the Conservation Fund for the appraisal of the Farnsworth property on Root Hill road assuming this is a legal use of that money. Gabe will check into the use of the conservation fund for this purpose. Rickey seconded. The motion was approved unanimously.
