Selectmen's Meeting Minutes  
July 2, 2010 2:00PM

Present: John Hammond, Troy Simino, Larry Dingee

1. Mr. Simons from Root Hill Road came in to inquire about the status of the Roberts property re: subdivision and driveway access to the Roberts property.
2. John Lyford from Mason & Rich, P.A. returned the Selectmen's calls over the last few months attempts to resolve an outstanding bill.
3. Nate Cass and Scott Reuthe came in upon request of the Board.
4. 2:40PM, a motion by Selectmen Simino was made to go into Executive Session with the Fire Chief and Assistant Fire Chief on a personnel issue.
5. Executive Session ended at 3:05PM.
6. The Selectboard inquired about status of digging out Fire Pond in the Flat. Selectmen will inquire on permitting process.
7. Dan Flynn came in to report on his findings on roadside mowing.
8. Motion made by Selectmen Dingee to instruct the Road Agent to follow the requirements spelled out in the Dig Safe Law (RSA 374), 2<sup>nd</sup> by Selectmen Simino and voted unanimous by the BOS.
9. Selectmen Hammonds informed Dan that the Board of Selectmen are moving forward with the Town Road Maintenance Plan and are requiring him to provide the BOS with a schedule of maintenance starting July 16, 2010 and continuing on a monthly basis.
10. The Selectmen received a letter from the Road Agent stating his disagreement with the Board's position on having our personnel doing the roadside mowing. His letter stated that if any breakage occurred that the funds would not be taken from the Highway Budget. Selectmen did not concur.
11. Selectmen inquired as to the process by the Road Agent allocating the disposal of roadside ditching.
12. Person from Census called to inquire as to who is the landowner on Hildreth Lane. He was referred to the Town Clerk.
13. Dan was instructed to develop a new system as to who received ditching material and report to the Selectmen.
14. Dan was asked to contact Mike Reynolds on Root Hill Road and instruct them to not start the driveway access until the application is approved.
15. John Cushing came in for a Pistol permit renewal application.
16. Mike Monette came in to discuss with the Board his opinion about the work done on Burr Road. Mike also left with the Selectmen, copies of several letters and Town paperwork in reference to the Fire Chief's job description.
17. Nancy Redfield came in for a building permit application for replacing a deck on her house.

30. Heather Meeks came in to check mail and to inquire about the backhoe purchase.
31. Selectmen review paperwork and signed checks.
32. Nancy Wightman came in to give her opinion about the ditching that has been done on Burr rd and Center rd. She feels that the ditches are too deep.
33. Rhonda Amadon came to tell the Selectboard that there are two trees at the corner of Leavitt Hill rd and Old Turnpike Rd. They are obstructing driver view and she is afraid that there may be an accident due to that. Rhonda would like to see the two trees removed.
34. Marie De Rusha, Dillon Gallagher and Fred Sullivan came in to discuss the road maintenance in regards to work that was done on Burr Rd and Center Rd. Dillon Gallagher feels that the ditching is too deep and wide and that the fill that is being taken out of there needs to stay within the town lines. Dillon stated that the shoulders on Center Rd for which the Highway crew has not ruined were specifically set in place for pedestrian and vehicle safety. Larry Dingee described the road plan draft and the past few discussions that the board has had with the Road Agent, Dan Flynn ie. communication, schedule, dig safe numbers. Fred Sullivan was upset to see what Mike Monette had written in the newspaper and on connect Cornish. Fred had conducted a survey asking questions to people about the work that Dan Flynn has completed on Burr Rd and most of the responders live on Burr Rd. Fred read aloud every person's remarks, which were mostly good reviews while two were not.
35. Gerry and Jeffery Baillargeon joined the discussion.
36. Jeff Baillargeon made the comment that ditching is important but deep ditches are dangerous. The town needs guidelines to protect ourselves and to follow; no policy is a bad thing. Jeff stated that trees are getting nicked and damaged by the town's equipment therefore they are rotting and need to come down. Jeff mentioned using a dense grade product on the roads instead of the round rock for they do not blend in well and beat up people's vehicles. The crew could also roll the roads after applying the product to help blend them in and to fix the tire popping problem that the Town has after product has been laid. Jeff also offered his help with the engineering and development with fixing the Clark Camp Bridge.
