

Cornish Conservation Commission  
Meeting Minutes for April 24 2013  
As Ammended

Meeting called to order by Chair Barker at 7:05pm

Present: Mariet, Bill, John, Rickey, Dale, Jen, Pat, Linda, Frank, Jim

Review of March minutes: Pat made first motion to accept as written seconded by Dale; motion passed.

Jim received a letter from the NH DOT informing of guardrail replacement to take place on RT 12A and RT 120 at some point this summer. There was some concern and discussion as to whether there would be a need for any tree cutting. Jim and Jen will ride out the proposed work areas on Sunday the 28th in the a.m.

A motion was made to extend the terms of Jim, Frank, Bill and Mariet will serve on the CCC. Ricky made first motion and was seconded by Dale. The motion passed.

NRI Update: very close to being done. Ricky will let Jim know when she has completed her part ;Linda will do the same. Editing will begin soon. The CCC will do a “debrief” soon and also will discuss how the NRI will be rolled out.

Jim read a letter from the Dept. Of Justice relative to guidelines from the American’s with Disabilities Act dealing with access to public places such as the CREA property and Town Forests etc. .A large component of this letter referenced Other Power Driven Mobility Devices and compliance issues with same. An e-copy of this letter will be given to the entire board. It was agreed by the board that there existed many options for compliance and that we could deal with them as they arose. Some assessing of properties that the town owned may also be in order.

A motion was made to reimburse Pat the amount of \$21.02 for expense incurred relative to the NRI. Dale made first motion to pass and was seconded by Linda. The motion passed.

Linda gave an update on recent problems in the Town forest and other areas in town caused by dirt bikers. She also said that we may participate in a Valley Quest. There was also discussion of using some areas of the town forest that could be delineated as study areas. Linda also gave an update on the CREA property and spoke briefly about the business plan for the same. This(Plan) will be discussed more at a later date. She did speak about long term maintenance concerns with the ball fields etc. and budgeting with its associated headaches. Ultimately ,she said, the governing board for all of it is really the town select board.

Jim gave an update on purchasing/planting some apple trees with a long term goal of free fruit for the townspeople. He will speak to the selectmen about a planting location.

A motion was made to adjourn by Dale and seconded by Frank at 8:40 pm
