

Cornish Conservation Commission Minutes.
July 23 2013

Jim called the meeting to order at 7.10 p.m.
June 26 minutes approved with correction (Pat/Dale).

N.R.I. (Natural Resources Inventory). Final Review.
Discussion of its formulation.

Linda stated that in the combined files of easements, held by the Town and the C.C.C., no mention was made of the dollar amount provided by the Conservation Commission in the transaction.

John suggested the C.C.C. should have a copy of the combined acquisition of the easement by the Town and the C.C.C. and only keep records of monitoring when the Commission is the primary holder.

Rickey stated that in easements records, mentioned in the N.R.I. the contribution of the C.C.C. should be mentioned in bold letters.

Class 6 Roads and Discontinued Roads. It should be mentioned that this information can be found in the records of the Town.

The Covered Bridge between Cornish and Windsor. It should be called Cornish Windsor Bridge/Covered Bridge.

The Fire Pond /Swimming Hole in the Flat. John suggested calling it a local swimming hole. He supports it to be called a swimming hole as a donation was made by a Town to maintain it as such. The Town should carry an increased insurance cost if needed.

Geological Map. Rachel should be asked if Surficial Information could be added to the map. (Suggestion of Bill).

GPS Training. The training, to be given by Steve Walker in Concord is rescheduled for July 31 in the same place from 4 - 7 pm.

North Star Delivery, property of John and Linda Hammond. John thanked the C.C.C. for its contribution towards the Easement through the Upper Valley Land Trust.

The Kings Elm Farm. The easement on the property of Bill and Jennifer Lipfert through the UVLT will be celebrated by the organization and the Commission. A date, 7th of September (9/8 as rain date), will be forwarded to the Lipfert's for their agreement.

The next N.R.I. Meeting with Rachel will be Wednesday August 28.

The Boy Scouts patches. Still not been solved.

Data of Easements. A spread sheet composed by Linda, with easements the Commission is involved with, is presented by Linda.

Jim will check the data with the Town secretary Mary Curtis.

The former Putnam Farm. The U.V.L.T. is making progress in acquiring an easement on the property, now owned by the Sprague Family in Plainfield.
