Notes from back of 1887 Diary

To prevent rust on tools Melt 1 oz resin in one gill of linseed oil and when hot mix with 2 guarts kerosene oil.

<u>To kill cabbage worms.</u> <u>Dissolve one table spoon of saltpeter in 6 quarts warm water</u> <u>&</u> <u>sprinkle.</u>

To protect squashes etc from bugs. Plant row of beans around each hill.
