Tennie Rock assembled these documents and Ginny Gage compiled them. Ginny made copies of the originals and placed both, with protective coverings, in notebooks available at the History Center. As part of her work, Ginny compiled Excel worksheets with the names by event/date. CHS has transformed them into the file below. To search by name, use Control-F.

Preface

When our Town Offices were being moved from their former location on School Street to the new location on Town House Road, there were many old papers discovered in the old safe. Unfortunately they were not in very good condition. Many had been torn and water soaked. MayBelle (Teenie) Rock took these papers home and salvaged what she could of them, eventually putting them in archival quality folders in a notebook.

The first page in the notebook is a typewritten *List of the Foot Militia Company in Cornish May the 25 AD 1776*, and the most recent is the *Enrollment of the Town of Cornish NH April 24 1891 (Militia)*. I have photocopied each page in this notebook and except for the mustering in and substitution pages, transcribed each page. This has not been easy, and I am sure I have made errors. Handwriting back then was beautiful but at times difficult to decipher.

Three copies have been made of this notebook. One copy will be at the Town Office, one with the Cornish Historical Society, and one at the George Stowell Library. The original will be at the Town Office.

I would like to thank Teenie for having the foresight to save and preserve these documents, and for allowing me to borrow them to copy and transcribe. It has been a difficult task at times, but one I have thoroughly enjoyed. This is part of our Town history, and for many residents, part of their family history.
