Discussion on whether the GSRWA might assist the Commission with evaluating water protection measures in Cornish Flat. CCC could consider educating residents on opportunities for water testing. Volunteer River Assessment Program

• State program that provides an assessment kit for \$2,000, which lasts 5-7 years. If we pursue this option, CCC would pay for sample test as well. Data collected populates a statewide database. Possible Tasker Fund application. Look into having DES do the testing at no cost and explore VRAP website for <u>grant options</u>.
