- 1. 7:30pm Call to Order by Corey Fitch.
- 2. The minutes of the May 25, 2022 (CCC Draft May 25, 2022 Minutes): Jody motioned and Linda seconded approval of the minutes; the minutes were unanimously approved as presented.
- 3. Alternate Member Vote on Anna Hubbard. Corey reported that Anna is relocating to Lebanon and decided not to pursue her candidacy as an alternate member of the CCC.

- 4. NRI Update NRI Workgroups (<u>NRI Workgroups/Schedule</u>) It was noted that these two sections will be reviewed at the July 27 meeting: IV, WATER RESOURCES (Glenn and Bob) and VII, Wildlife Habitat (Cindy, Reyer, Rickey).
 - a. IV Water Resources-Glenn and Bob (Section IV Water Resources be sure you are in SUGGESTING mode) Since Glenn cannot attend on June 29, this section is pushed to the July 27 meeting.
 - b. V Agriculture-Corey, Bob, and Linda (<u>Section V, Agriculture be sure you are in SUGGESTING mode</u>). Corey led the CCC through the suggested edits noting Linda agreed to research the National Agricultural Survey statistics (re: table 6 Commercial Farms in Cornish) and NH climate change assessment for relevancy to this section.

 - c. **NHDOT Letter (NH DOT Letter 2-17-11)**: Update/Corey. Corey emailed NHDOT asking their confirmation on a proposed work scope. NHDOT responded that the northeast wing needs repair summer of 2023. **Action:** Corey will respond to this letter.
 - d. **Land Monitoring:** Rickey will reach out by email to Jim Barker, hoping in early July to plan to monitor his back acres east and west. She will also reach out to Charlie Shurtliff and Neidecker. **Action:** Rickey will notify the CCC members of any upcoming monitoring dates.

 - i. Bill Ladd's Property Corey notes that Bill continues to make progress, but nothing is happening quickly. Corey will stay in touch and update the CCC as appropriate.

He will develop a detailed budget and project description. It is anticipated that the CCC will pay for ½ of the budget and SPNHF will cover ½ of the budget.
