George H. Stowell Library Trustee Meeting Monday, September 12, 2022 at 6:00 pm at the Stowell Library

- 1. Call to Order at 6:03 pm
- 2. Trustee minutes for July 23 (Public Forum), August 2 (Trustee), August 10 (Renovation work session), August 16 (w/LEC), August 23 (trustee-work session for budgets), September 6 (w/LEC), September 7 (trustee w/Dana Anderson) were approved as emailed
- 3. Treasurer's Report. Patterson distributed the YTD budget. There is \$16,896 in the building fund. This is a possible source of funding the soft costs of the new building. The library capital reserve fund was established in March of 2000 with \$2,000, and added to since. There is currently a balance of over \$74,000. The trustees will consult a lawyer on who controls the funds and who has access to them. The Trustees accepted the Treasurer's report.

It was noted that other libraries have different categories for their budgets. Some separate books, some combine books with digital resources. Some designate the category as "library materials," or "collections."

Patterson circulated the Operating Expenses budget requested by the Exploratory Committee that she constructed. Reviewing Banwell's new estimate, it was noted that it includes lighting and plug loads. **Decision: Electricity and Heat/AC will be combined. \$6,102 (based on increase to \$.20 KWH) plus \$500 for kitchen costs.** We are still waiting for MA+KE's cost estimate for heat/ac and electricity.
