- 1. Call To Order/Jody. In Corey's absence, Jody called the meeting to order at 7pm.
- 2. Approve the <u>Draft CCC Minutes January 10, 2024 (NRI Maps Meeting)</u>. Linda motioned and Glenn seconded approval of the draft minutes as distributed. The members voted unanimously in favor of the motion, and the draft minutes were approved.
- 3. Treasurer's Report (Robin). There was no report, but one will be available for our next meeting.
- 4. Subcommittee Reports: Subcommittee
 - a. Land Conservation Plan. No report.
 - b. Town Water Protection Plan: Jody noted that there has been a change in Endyne's pick up service and she posted notices through ConnectCornish and updated the appropriate notice locations.
 - c. Education Plan. Jody said she is waiting for the principal to approve the owl prowl walk tentatively scheduled for March. Rickey will write an article for the CCC Conservation Notes in February: What is a Wildlife Corridor/Wildlife Habitat in Cornish.
 - d. Land Monitoring. No report.
- 5. NRI Update: Maps Workshop January 10, 2024 (Map Proposal from UVLT) (NRI Update Maps Working Document). No further report at this time. Rickey commented that the Select Board should have no authority in signing the contract since the money is coming from the Commission Fund. This fund is managed solely by the CCC and only the CCC should be a signor.
- 6. CCC Website/Linda- nothing to report. Suggestions from CCC members are encouraged and welcome.
- 7. Other Business
 - a. Hooper Conservation. Rickey said that the Upper Valley Land Trust announced that the easement has been completed.
 - b. CCC Hats/Linda. Hat Logo/Color Options. It was decided that the logo would be white in color and be the one with Cornish Conservation Commission arced above the tree; and the hat color would be emerald green. It is noted that if there is a more subtle green, a forest green, that would be preferable. Corey will make the final decisions on hat and logo colors depending on availability, and Linda will submit a draft order to the Ink Factory for pricing and availability.
